Bankruptcy Attorney Opens New Legal Practice in Stamford

Stamford – Stamford and lower Fairfield County residents facing foreclosure, or unmanageable credit card debt, can now turn to the Law Office of George H. Bankruptcy protections are powerful but not always the best option for every debt problem.”

Connecticut has the third highest credit card debt per borrower nationwide. The total number of consumer bankruptcies filed in Connecticut during the first six months of 2008 increased 42.2 percent over the same period in 2007, according to data released by the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts. Weber’s clients are primarily middle-class individuals who have experienced a substantial income reduction, triggered by lay offs or work missed due to illness. Some are facing medical problems with little or no insurance coverage. Still others have been caught in the mortgage crisis. Weber also collaborates with organizations and individuals whose aim it is to assist those in financial difficulties.

Once a client has signed on, Weber works with them to determine the best course of action – straight bankruptcy vs. debt reorganization for example – and then guides them through the entire filing process. His initial consultation is free and he only charges once someone requests assistance with bankruptcy filing.
